Attorneys and Litigants representing themselves in Small Claims and Eviction cases in Madison County can now file documents in these case-types electronically. Mark Von Nida, Madison County Circuit Clerk has partnered with NCourt LLC, an electronic filing document software provider, to introduce this new service available to attorneys and the public.

“The Circuit Clerk’s office is very excited to offer an electronic format for filing court documents in Small Claims and Evictions. My office has offered electronic filing for asbestos cases since 2008. In 2013 the Illinois Supreme Court approved e-filing for all civil case types in Madison County. We plan to expand our e-filing services throughout the entire Circuit Clerk’s office within the next two (2) years.”

“NCourt will charge a one-time convenience fee of \$10.00 to electronically file documents in a case.” Von Nida said. “Electronic filing is a win/win for both the court system and the parties involved in the case. NCourt enables litigants and/or their attorney to submit documents online without leaving their home or office. It also allows the Circuit Clerk’s office to receipt, assign a new case number and file the document in the court management software system all in one transaction.” Von Nida stated.

The electronic filing software is available 365 days a year and 24 hours a day. Documents filed after 12:00 are will be approved and file stamped by the Circuit Clerk’s office the next business day.
