Are You A Registered Voter?

You can register to vote if you are:

- A United States citizen
- A resident of your Madison County precinct address for at least 30 days immediately prior to an election.

Two forms of identification are required to register.
At least one of the two forms must show your name and current address.

You can register to vote:

- Register in-person at the County Clerk's office - 157 North Main Street, Edwardsville, IL 62025. **618-692-6290**, at any Early Voting site, or at your polling place on Election Day.
- Register on-line before March 20, 2017 at www.MadisonVotes.com. You need an up-to-date Illinois Driver License or Illinois State ID.

Who is qualified to vote by mail?

If you are registered to vote in Madison County, you are eligible to cast a ballot by mail.

In addition, the following unregistered voters are eligible to vote by mail:

- Members of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marine and their spouses and dependents whether serving in the United States or abroad whose permanent residence is in Madison County;
- U.S. citizens and their spouses or dependents, whose permanent residence is in Madison County but who will be temporarily residing abroad on election day;
- U.S. citizens (not their spouses or dependents) who maintained a residence in Madison County immediately prior to their departure from the United States.

The Vote by Mail Balloting Process

1. Verify Voter Registration
2. Get an application to vote by mail
3. Fill out and send application to vote by mail to the County Clerk's office
4. Receive vote by mail ballot packet
5. Return vote by mail ballot packet

**Vote by mail ballot packets must be complete. They are often returned because the application is not signed or the application is not included or no signature on affidavit or ballot not in official affidavit envelope.*

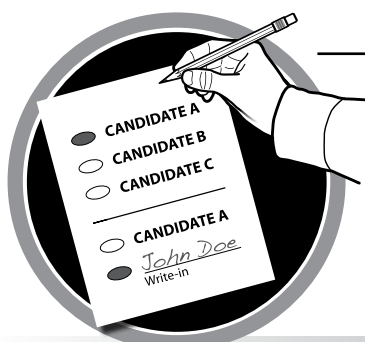
There are two ways to complete an application to vote by mail. Go to www.MadisonVotes.com. Select **Click Here to Vote By Mail**, verify your registration, and then download either the Mail-in paper application or download the E-mail application that you send to us as an attachment.

Casting Your Ballot

- 1. Receive your ballot** Enter the polling place and give your name and address to an Election Judge. Complete and sign an Application to Vote. Upon verification, the election judge will give you:

- a paper ballot
- a privacy cover

- 2. Enter the voting booth and mark your ballot** Enter the next available voting booth. To vote the optical scan ballot, completely fill in the oval to the left of the candidate or public question of your choice. Be sure to mark both sides of your ballot if needed. If you make a mistake marking your ballot, return it to an Election Judge to receive a new ballot.



To Vote: Completely fill in the oval next to the candidate/write-in/proposition of your choice(s), with the marking pen provided.

Write-in Votes: If you wish to vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot you may print the name of the candidate in the blank space below the office. Write-in votes are counted only for those candidates who file a "Declaration of Intent" to be a write-in candidate. A complete list is on our website www.MadisonVotes.com

If you make a mistake you need a new ballot: Return the ballot to an Election Judge who will provide you with a replacement.

- 3. Vote!** Cover your ballot with the privacy sleeve and insert the ballot into the ballot tabulator. The Optical Scan System complies with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) to provide voters an opportunity to check for and correct ballot errors (for example, casting more votes for an office than allowed results in an overvote). If an error is detected, the system will gently beep and give you the option to accept the ballot as is (the overvoted office will not count) or you may return the ballot to an Election Judge and receive a new ballot.
