**AMENDING INDUSTRIAL WASTE SURCHARGE
OF MADISON COUNTY ORDINANCE 2004-6**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency requires that sewer user charges be established in such amount as to assure that each recipient of sewer services will pay its proportionate share of costs of operations and maintenance, including replacement costs; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance amends Ordinance 2004-6, (Chapter III, Article I, Section 4, Industrial Waste Surcharge).

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MADISON COUNTY BOARD as follows:

1. Section 2 (Industrial Waste Surcharge) of Ordinance 2004-6 is hereby amended as more particularly set forth below.
2. Section 2 of Ordinance 2004-6 is hereby repealed.
3. Hereafter, Section 2 shall state:

Wherever sewage or industrial waste discharge from any lot, parcel of land or premises in the sanitary sewerage system has suspended solids (TSS) in content in excess of two hundred fifty (250) milligrams per liter or biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) in excess of two hundred (200) milligrams per liter as determined by test conducted or supervised by the Superintendent, there shall be an additional charge of surcharge as follows:

- (a) \$0.39 per lb of TSS per 1,000 gallons sewage
- (b) \$0.35 per lb of BOD per 1,000 gallons sewage

This surcharge shall be charged and paid in addition to all other charges.

4. An increase of 3% annually will be applied to the Industrial Waste Surcharge each of the next 5 years.
5. The new rates set forth hereinabove shall be effective for services provided to industrial sewer users on or after the 1st day of May, 2010, and the increases (3% per year) applied the same day of each year thereafter.
6. Waste surcharge per Ordinance 2004-6 shall remain in effect until the date upon which the rates set forth hereinabove become effective.

7. Chapter III, Article I, Section 4 of Ordinance 96-12 (as amended heretofore) is amended hereby.

**AMENDING SEWER USER RATES
OF MADISON COUNTY ORDINANCE 2005-07**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency requires that sewer user charges be established in such amount as to assure that each recipient of sewer services will pay its proportionate share of costs of operations and maintenance, including replacement costs.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MADISON COUNTY BOARD as follows:

1. Section 3 (User Rates) of Ordinance 2005-07 is hereby amended as more particularly set below.
2. Section 3 (a), and (b) of Ordinance 2005-07 is hereby repealed.
3. Hereafter, Section 3 (a), and (b) shall state:
 - (a) Residential users shall be charged a fixed rate of \$27.95 per month for all single family residences.
 - (b) Commercial users, industrial users, mobile home parks, and all multiple family dwellings (dwellings containing two or more living units) shall be charged the larger of the following:
 1. Either \$83.85 per calendar quarter where water consumption or metered sewer usage is equal to or less than 16,425 gallons for the quarter or
 2. Thirty-five and four-tenths cents (\$.354) per 100 gallons for all water consumption or metered sewer usage plus \$25.73 per quarter.

If there is no meter, the fee shall be an agreed amount, and if there is not agreement, the fee shall be Two hundred dollars (\$200.00) monthly.

- (c) The user rates for residential, commercial, mobile home parks and industrial users have been established to assure that each recipient of waste treatment services will bear its proportionate share of costs.
4. An increase of 3% annually will be applied to the User Rate each of the next 5 years.
5. The new rates set forth hereinabove shall be effective for services provided to sewer users on or after the 1st day of May, 2010, and increases (3%) per year applied the same day of each year thereafter.

6. The current rates per Ordinance 2005-07 shall remain in effect until the date upon which the rates set forth hereinabove become effective.
7. In all other respects Ordinance 96-12, as heretofore amended, shall remain in full force and effect including, but not by way of limitation, the surcharges established under ordinances passed September 17, 2003.
8. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are amended hereby.
