### **Sanitarian** (Health Department)

Qualifications: A Bachelor of Science degree from an accredited college or university with a minimum of 30 semester hours or equivalent in the basic sciences and/or biological sciences; and

Be registered by the State of Illinois as an Environmental Health Practitioner in Training or Licensed Environmental Health Practitioner (LEHP); and

A valid driver's license is also required.

### **EXAMPLES OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- reviews plans, issues permits, inspects food service facilities, private sewage disposal systems, private water supplies, and other environmental health related services/programs
- investigates complaints involving possible sanitary violations in the environmental field, offers recommendations on solutions and makes follow-up inspections
- completes activity reports, records of inspections, investigations, and correspondence; answers inquiries of complainants and the general public which require technical and scientific knowledge
- participates in epidemiological surveys, including but not limited to foodborne illness investigations, seeking methods of control and correction; collects environmental samples as required
- conducts public in-services on environmental health programs and services
- performs duties as trainer for new employees
- performs other duties as required or assigned which are reasonably within the scope of the duties enumerated above
