D. Burch informed the committee that the public access terminal room is now open. She also mentioned that there will be a National Adoption Day on November 19<sup>th</sup>. She also mentioned Granite City went live with the E-Citation program.

### **SHERIFF:**

J. Conner handed out the monthly jail report to the committee. He informed the committee that compared to 2015 report, we are 500 over the number of inmates from this time last year.

J. Conner commended Deputy Goode and Deputy Trent for their life saving skills they performed on an employee a few weeks back.

The following purchase requests were presented to the committee:

1. The Circuit Court is purchasing a defense lawyer for a sexually violent defendant. The cost is \$17,637.38.
2. The Sheriff's Department is purchasing 20 surveillance cameras and accessories. The cost is \$12,027.68.
