**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Leady Van Cavage addressed the committee and Animal Control regarding the monthly statistical report of the animal control department.

**PURCHASE REQUESTS:**

E. Decker presented the following purchase requests:

1. The request to purchase 9 razor body armors. The cost is \$6,525.00.
